

Tassel Tunic (Tunisian Crochet)

We used approx 500 grams tape yarn. 25mm Tunisian Crochet Hook.

Using 2 strands of yarn held together.

Back: Working in traditional tunisian crochet stitch throughout. Make a chain of 32 stitches. Crochet 32 rows. Cast off. You will have 1 rectangle. *(This is the back of the tunic)*

Front: Make a chain of 32 stitches and work as before in traditional stitch. Crochet 29 rows. Cast off. You will have a shorter rectangle.

Note: The Back is longer than the Front giving it a more current look.

Make up: Place back and front with right sides and cast on edges together *(these will be the shoulders of your tunic)*. Sew a shoulder seam of approx 15cm from each end leaving room to put head through. We did not sew up the side seams but left them free and added a belt for definition.

Tassels: Cut yarn into 36cm lengths and using 2 lengths at a time fold in half and insert at bottom edge into each loop to form tassels. *If unsure how to make tassels there is lots of info on the web.*

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
